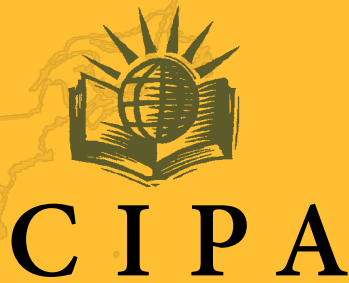

## EMORY INTERDISCIPLINARY INTERNSHIPS IN S. AFRICA

### Interdisciplinary Internships in Cape Town, South Africa

May 13- June 17, 2009

Intern at newspapers, radio stations, or magazines; teach and assist elementary or high school instructors; or engage in meaningful community service in Cape Town. The program offers students the opportunity to work as interns in a variety of fields. The first four weeks will be spent interning and seeing the daily life in Cape Town. Weekend excursions will consist of explorations of the winelands, Cape Point, and other landmarks. The program will travel to Johannesburg at the internship's close.

*All program participants take one course worth with Emory credit hours.*

**JRNL 401/AFS 389/ EDS 497R**, Internship in South Africa (*Shelia Tefft, Emory University*)

**Eligibility:** Applicants must have at least a 2.0 cumulative GPA, be at least 18 years of age, completed of one full year of college, be in good academic standing, and be currently enrolled in a university/college. Additionally, applicants to this program must have taken an introductory psychology course or the equivalent.

All applicants must submit to CIPA an Emory Summer Study Abroad Application (on-line) with accompanying documents and a \$350 non-refundable deposit. The application deadline is February 2, 2009; early application is always advisable as some programs fill before the deadline.
